'The role of the railways in the First World War' (speaker Phil Cook).

Railways played an essential role during the First World War being able to transport men, armaments and equipment to vital destinations quickly. Raw materials, fuel and finished products needed for the war effort were moved in bulk to and from the factories which were working at full capacity. Sadly, ambulance trains also had to be introduced to move the wounded to the auxiliary hospitals set up in many communities across the country including Hoole.
