

Matthew 5:16 Sermon on the Mount

Armistice Day is a very important day in our school calendar. We marked this special event with a special whole school worship.

Pupils of all ages, from our youngest to oldest children, joined with staff and representatives from the Board of Governors for our annual remembrance service.

During the service, we remembered the bravery of soldiers like Noel Chavasse VC and Johnson Beharry VC.

We learnt about Ulric Cross, a soldier who travelled from Trinidad to join the Royal Air Force at the age of twenty-four. Ulric played a key role in World War 2 as a pathfinder with Bomber Command. He progressed to the rank of Squadron Leader and was awarded with medals, including the Distinguished Flying Medal, for this courage and determination in battle.

At our school Cenotaph, wreaths from representatives of every class were received from Lily and Leon. These pupils were selected to honour their older brother, who is a serving soldier in the British Army.

The two minutes silence at the end of our service was impeccably observed by every member of our school family. I am extremely proud to lead this wonderful school.
