

All Saints Alternative Lent Supper 2021 Week 2

This Week's Soup: Leek and Potato (A real favourite of any Lent Supper)

Use this recipe from the Lent Supper Recipe Book or your own favourite recipe.

5 medium leeks	2 oz butter
3 good sized potatoes (diced)	1 medium onion – chopped
salt & pepper	1½ pts vegetable stock
pinch nutmeg	¼ pint double cream



Wash and slice leeks about ½ inch thick use as much of the green as possible. Wash the leeks well.

Melt the butter in a saucepan and add onions, cook over a moderate heat until they begin to soften but not brown. Now add potato and leeks, cook for another 2 minutes and then add the stock.

Cook on a moderate heat until the potatoes are tender. Add cream and season. Do not boil the soup once the cream is added. Finish with a sprinkle of nutmeg.
