Pastoral Care for those not in groups – how to make contact with team

A new Pastoral Care Team for All Saints has been established recently.

The purpose of the team is to provide care for those who are NOT in one of the groups which already provide pastoral care such as the Communities and Oasis. So, if you are not in one of the groups and you, for example, end up in hospital, are stuck at home, or would appreciate someone getting alongside you, a member of the team can meet with you, listen and pray with you if that's what you'd like.

Also if you know someone that is in these circumstances, and you have their permission, you can request that they receive care.

If you are already being visited by someone or if you are visiting someone, please don't stop! We are not trying to replace wonderful care that is already happening.

Hoole Church of England Primary School Shakespeare Festival

Pupils at Hoole Church of England Primary have enjoyed their annual School Shakespeare Festival in May.

Children at Hoole are great fans of the famous British writer and, over the last four years, have become familiar with some of his most famous works.

Students have enjoyed professional performances of 'Twelfth Night,' 'Romeo & Juliet,' 'A Midsummer Night's Dream' and 'The Tempest.'

Members of the school's Shakespeare Clubs have also entertained with performances of 'Much Ado About Nothing,' 'Macbeth' and 'Romeo and Juliet.'

Year 5 & 6 club members performed 'A Midsummer Night's Dream' to packed houses for two nights with the Year 3 & 4 club presenting the tragedy, 'Hamlet.'

The club members had attended the free extra-curricular clubs for many weeks, rehearsing after school to perfect their performances.

Both plays had Shakespearean language and some of the most famous extracts from the plays woven into the script.

The two performances were also taken on the road! Children performed both plays at the Belong Care Village in Chester to packed houses. Children were commended on their confidence and their stagecraft in bringing the plays to life in such an imaginative and skilled manner.

We are proud that Hoole children know so much about Shakespeare and have such a great understanding of the features of his plays. We feel that this gives them so much confidence so that when they encounter Shakespearean works in secondary school and beyond, they will be well prepared to shine very brightly.

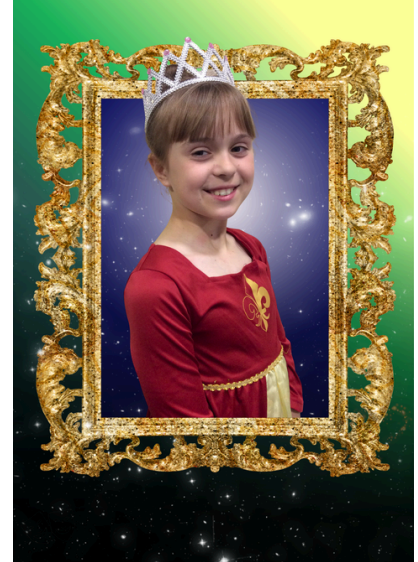
