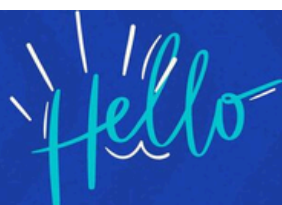

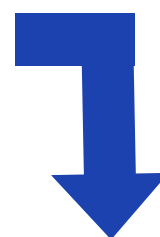

This week, we launched information about our after school clubs offer for this term.

Once again, the fantastic staff team have generously offered to give up their time to enable us to offer an outstanding array of opportunities for children to find new ways to shine, beyond the school curriculum.

Clubs this year include Science Club, netball, mixed sports, football, streetdance, arts and crafts, Zentangle, Lego, dodgeball and streetdance. All but two of the clubs, which are offered by external providers, are absolutely free to families so there is no barrier to anyone in our school family joining.

We are also bringing back our popular Family running club. This provides a chance for families to run together every week (whilst the lighter evenings are still with us) to keep fit and stay healthy.
