

COMMUNICATION FOLLOWING THE PUBLICATION OF THE MAKIN REVIEW

In light of the publication of the Makin review, the Bishop of Chester has written a letter to our Diocese, expressing his thoughts and urging us to pray. We wanted to make sure that everyone connected to our church can read it, where possible. *Please click here to read*.

May I take this opportunity as vicar of All Saints to express my own sorrow regarding this devastating situation which, as we have been made aware, includes the lack of transparency and action within the highest levels of the Church.

I would like to assure you that All Saints is committed to continuing to provide and develop excellent safeguarding care for all in our parish and beyond and will strive to be a place and people where everyone, including the most vulnerable are protected. My sincere thanks to everyone within our staff and volunteer teams who are working extremely hard to make this a reality.

As Bishop Mark writes in his letter, safeguarding is a shared responsibility. Please continue to play your part in being vigilant, mindful and prayerful and join me in praying for ongoing wisdom (James 1v5) as we seek to embody the Good News of Jesus together.

NEWS FROM HOOLE CHURCH OF ENGLAND PRIMARY SCHOOL

Matthew 5:16 Sermon on the Mount

We celebrated a very special day in the national calendar on Monday 11th November.

Our school family came together to commemorate Armistice Day. We held our annual service to show our respects for the brave soldiers who have sacrificed so much for our country.

Children enjoyed a service including many of their own contributions. We enjoyed a song written by a Year three pupil, describing how beautiful the battlefields became once the poppies began to grow. We shared prayers, presented by representatives of the Ethos Committee. Several children brought artefacts, including medals which had been won by members of their family in conflicts.

We recreated the cenotaph and representatives from each class came forward to lay their wreaths. These were received by one of our Year five pupils, whose brother is on active service with the British army.

Our service was made all the more special as we welcomed Blue Coat Trustees to our service. Thank you to those who attended to commemorate with us.

One of our pupils reflected later, "When we did our two minutes silence, I felt grateful and thankful for the soldiers who fought for peace in our world. It is really important that we don't forget them because they gave a massive sacrifice for us. I cannot imagine the pain they went through and the families who lost their mums, dads, sisters, brothers or friends."

After our service, pupils and visitors laid poppies in our Remembrance Garden at the front of school.
