CONFIRMATION SERVICE

Apprenticeship to Jesus is an ongoing journey, so having landmark moments to publicly say, “Yes — I want to keep following Jesus”, can be powerful reminders of this journey with him.

For some people, especially those baptised as children, a confirmation service can be a really meaningful moment of saying for themselves what others once said on their behalf. For others, it can be a fresh step of commitment in a faith they are already living out. Either way, it is a simple but powerful way of marking your desire to keep growing as a Christian, with the encouragement and prayers of the wider Church.

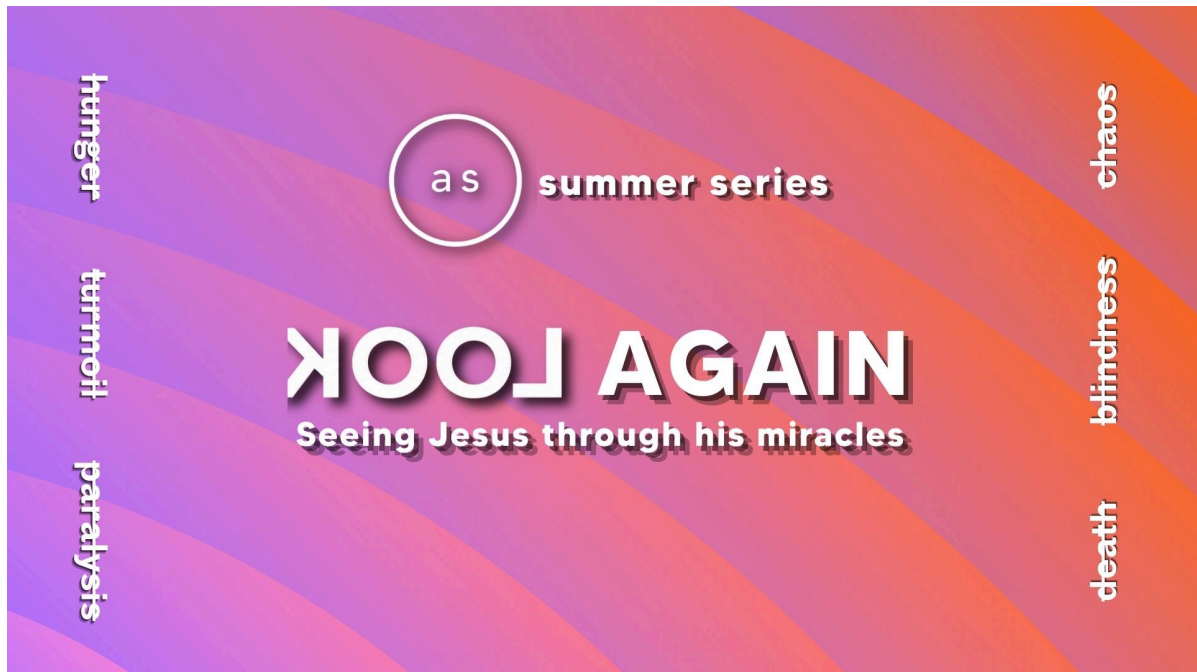
It is also an opportunity to ask God to strengthen you by his Holy Spirit as you continue learning what it means to live with, like and for Jesus.

We’ll be running three relaxed preparation sessions (probably on a Sunday after a service) for anyone who’d like to find out more, ask questions, and think through whether confirmation might be the right next step.

The confirmation service will be on **Sunday 22nd November at 5pm at All Saints, with the Bishop of Chester, Mark Tanner**, who will pray for each candidate.

Adults and young people from school year 7 upwards who have been baptised are warmly invited. If you’re curious, interested, or even just wondering whether this is for you, we’d love you to come along.
