Jesse and Agi Update, April 2026



It's just over a year since the Rowe family visited us at All Saints from Khovd, Mongolia. Jesse and Agi told us about their plans for an accessible indoor play facility, particularly for the vulnerable children that Jesse works with and particularly for the winter months when the temperature can drop to -30 degrees.

Sunny but still cold in Mongolia

At the time Jesse was hopeful of construction starting in 2026 which seemed ambitious, but progress has been rapid. The site has now been officially transferred and a redesign involving local Mongolian input is now complete. There are international teams ready and willing to come and help with the construction, but the funding is still short of the target.

A further £36,000 needs to be raised by 8th May if the building is to go ahead as planned. Otherwise construction will be delayed until later in the year or next Spring. Jesse and Agi are praying and trusting in God's timing.

There are many other ways to help:

- **There are spaces on the construction teams**
- **You could go and join the team to pray over the land, the work and the ministry**
- **Cooks are needed to provide meals for the builders**

Just let Alan know and he can put you in touch with Jesse.

Jesse is also working hard, in partnership with local organisations, to better understand the real needs in the community. The ideology shaping the project reflects the idea that "The vulnerable people we work with shouldn't just be eating at the table, they should be in the kitchen designing the menu".

Please continue to pray for wisdom, provision, and steady progress in the months ahead.

Pastoral Care for those not in groups – how to make contact with team

A new Pastoral Care Team for All Saints has been established recently.

The purpose of the team is to provide care for those who are NOT in one of the groups which already provide pastoral care such as the Communities and Oasis. So, if you are not in one of the groups and you, for example, end up in hospital, are stuck at home, or would appreciate someone getting alongside you, a member of the team can meet with you, listen and pray with you if that's what you'd like.

Also if you know someone that is in these circumstances, and you have their permission, you can request that they receive care.

If you are already being visited by someone or if you are visiting someone, please don't stop! We are not trying to replace wonderful care that is already happening.

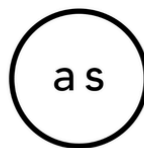
