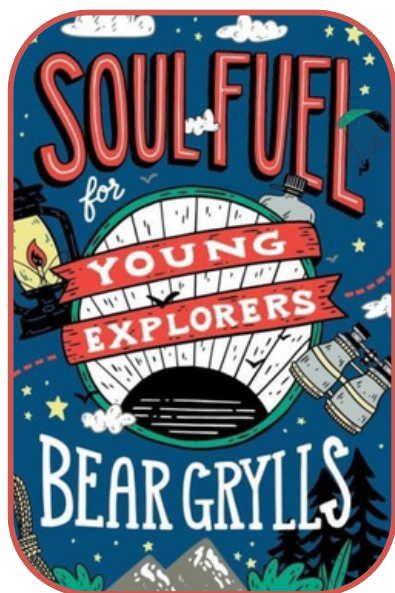

Pastoral Care for those not in groups – how to make contact with team

A new Pastoral Care Team for All Saints has been established recently.

The purpose of the team is to provide care for those who are NOT in one of the groups which already provide pastoral care such as the Communities and Oasis. If you are already being visited by someone or if you are visiting someone, please don't stop! We are not trying to replace wonderful care that is already happening.

NEWS FROM HOOLE CHURCH OF ENGLAND PRIMARY SCHOOL

'let your light shine' Matthew 5:16 Sermon on the Mount

We are celebrating more success at Hoole!

We are delighted to have retained our Platinum School Sports Award. This is a fantastic achievement which highlights the array of sports opportunities accessed by pupils of all ages and abilities at our school. During the academic year, we operate a wide variety of after school clubs to support children's mental and physical health. Children also access a range of tournaments and sports festivals to extend and apply their sporting skills.

Over the coming weeks, the swimming pool will return to school for three weeks! During this period, all children from Reception to Year six enjoy swimming lessons to build water confidence and develop their swimming stamina.

On a separate note, we recently celebrated attainment of the Bronze Rail Safe award.

We have also now attained the Silver level of the national Rail Safe award. We are not stopping there and are now working towards our Gold award!

We recognise our role in ensuring that children are equipped to be safe and responsible citizens in the community. Our attainment of the Rail Safe awards, in recognition of our work to equip children to understand the dangers of railway lines, is a good example.

In addition, Year five pupils visited the Safety Central Centre in Lymm, near Warrington on Wednesday. Safety Central is an interactive centre based around an indoor village. It boasts world-class special effects and the latest technology to simulate a range of hazards and risks. Talented rangers lead visitors through four themed zones and set exciting challenges and activities that encourage learning through hands-on experience.

Pupils were taught about how to prevent fires and learning also explores safety on the roads, near trains and around water, as well as issues such as healthy living, anti-social behaviour and online safety.

It was wonderful to receive more positive reports about our pupils' behaviour and engagement during this trip!
