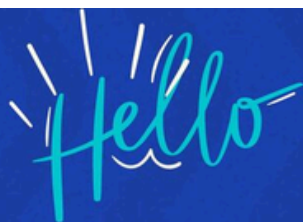

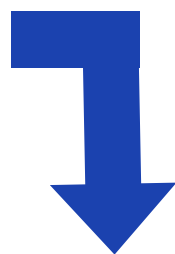

We welcomed our Year six pupils back to school on Friday afternoon after their North Wales adventure!

Children showed resilience, enthusiasm, perseverance...all of the wonderful qualities we promote in our school.

They supported each other to shine brightly, with children taking on challenges, such as high ropes courses, which took them outside of their comfort zone. Staff returned to school delighted that pupils were commended on their excellent behaviour, listening skills and attention, and also full of stories of children beaming with pride when they achieved a challenge they initially feared.

We hope that the courage and determination they have shown during their visit to the Glan Llyn Centre will help them to navigate their final year of primary school and the transition to secondary education.

We have had a busy week in school with the start of our extra-curricular programme on Monday.

Our autumn term after school clubs offer really does have something for everyone. We have an array of sports clubs for all ages this term, including badminton, girls' football, dodgeball, football clubs for Year 1 & 2, 3 & 4 and 5 & 6, street dance and netball clubs.
