

NEWS FROM HOOLE CHURCH OF ENGLAND PRIMARY SCHOOL

'let your light shine'

Matthew 5:16 Sermon on the Mount

We are celebrating again at Hoole Church of England Primary School!

We have attained two awards over the last two weeks in recognition of the work of our school.

Recently the government announced the outcome of the curriculum review. It is proposed that teaching children about financial literacy will become part of the primary curriculum. This proposal aims to ensure that pupils are equipped with the knowledge and skills to manage their finances positively in the future.

At Hoole, we have worked hard to develop financial education in ourschool. The school bank, the first in the area opened in partnership with West Cheshire Credit Union, continues to go from strength to strength under the leadership of our pupil bankers. We have worked in partnership with children and their families to extend financial learning.

As a result of our work, we have been awarded the Financial Excellence Award from the Centre for Financial Excellence. We are proud that we have been recognised as providing practical, effective and sustainable financial education for the young people at our school.

Our second award is the Gold level of the Young Carers Award. This prestigious award, presented by Cheshire Young Carers, recognises the strength of the systems in our school for identifying and supporting children who hold caring responsibilities within their families.

I am fortunate to have a tremendous staff team who are highly ambitious for the success of our school. I thank them all for their contribution to ensuring that our systems, curriculum and pastoral care are so strong and dynamic.
