

Members of our choir were in action at the AmaSING concert at The Storyhouse in Chester. The pupils, Mrs Inns and Mrs Stirk did an amazing job representing our school alongside children from several other local schools. I am really proud of the way in which they performed and also how well they conducted themselves on what was a very long afternoon and evening event. Thank you also to the parents, friends and family members who went along for the show.

On Tuesday evening, the school was alive with teams of children demonstrating how we have enriched our curriculum with innovative use of ICT and technology. We have invested heavily in ICT resources and training for staff to ensure that children have the opportunity to use technology to enhance all areas of learning. From Reception to Year six, parents and carers were invited to come to school for our ICT showcase. Pupils led demonstrations of the technology, explaining what they had learnt and how this improved learning. Visitors who attended had opportunities to trial a green screen, move Beebots by creating a program, send messages via Codebugs, create three dimensional models and present information via I-Movie and lots more! The children who presented workshops were very enthusiastic and did a great job of supporting visitors to trial the activities.

The evening was a great success and I would like to thank Mrs Salisbury, our ICT leader, the staff team and the ICT pupil ambassadors who worked hard to make this so successful.

Between now and the end of term, there are so many activities planned which will provide even more opportunities for children to shine brightly. I look forward to enjoying these with family members over coming weeks.
