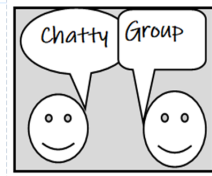

"Thank you teachers!"

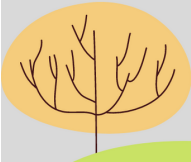
"Thanks for the support you have given X over the last six years. He has really enjoyed his time at Hoole."

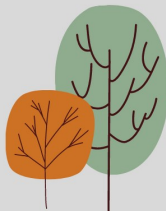
Summer camp out is going to be amazing!
