



Hoole Church of England Primary School

We are keen to work in partnership with external partners to enable our pupils to let their lights shine brightly as tolerant, responsible and compassionate citizens. We are involved in a partnership between several local schools and over this term, our school has led an exciting project to raise money for some of the poorest communities around the globe.



Clare Watling, our Deputy Headteacher, has developed a pupil forum comprising of representatives from all of the schools in our partnership. This term, children from local primary schools and Upton High School have collaborated to raise over £800 for the charity Toilet Twinning, which provides toilet facilities and sanitation to the poorest areas in the world.

Year 5 pupils from the primary schools and Year 7 pupils from Upton High have met online and planned education sessions for teaching their peers about the need for clean water in different areas. Following these sessions, the cross-school forum has organised fundraising activities in their schools. Activities have included crazy sock days, wearing 'blue for the loo' and dress up days where children have dressed up in the colours of the countries the charity works in.



The fund raised will be used to build three toilet blocks overseas. In addition, a donation of several brand new potty chairs was made to a local organisation, Kidsbank in Chester. This ensured that there was not just a global, but also a local dimension, to the work of the children.



This cross pupil-forum will continue in the new year. Given recent COVID related developments, it is likely to continue to meet as an online forum in the spring term. However, they are busy planning their next project and I have no doubt that it will be a resounding success given the dedication and commitment shown this term!
