Clearing up at the end of the day

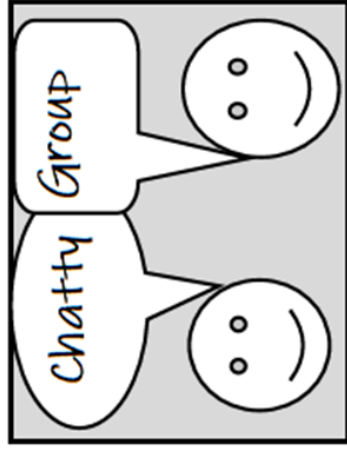
Giving lifts (bringing guests to the Church Centre for 11.30am and collecting them at 3.30pm)

## Cathy Armstrong – Madagascar

She's coming home!! On Wednesday, 9<sup>th</sup> June, Cathy and Louise set off from Mandritsara on a gruelling 24 hour road trip to the capital city, Tana. The first day will be particularly bad as the 'road' is pretty non-existent especially after the rainy season; they will travel with a driver and private car.

Their international flights are booked with Air France overnight on Tuesday, 15<sup>th</sup> June with a transit stop in Paris before flying on to Manchester/Dublin. During their few days in Tana they will need to get a negative Covid test within 72 hours of flying, and then more tests and quarantine at home once back in the UK.

Please remember them in your prayers over this coming week, especially:

- For safety on the roads and endurance throughout the long, uncomfortable ride. (Cathy is prone to travel sickness).
- That the necessary Covid tests would be available and that the results will be negative.
- That the AF flights will not be cancelled and that both Cathy and Louise make their connections in Paris ( They have been able to get tickets on special 'relief' flights as the borders are still closed for all travellers.)

Thank you for all your love and support for Cathy over the past 2 years. She will be home for about 4 months before heading back to Madagascar, so during that time will hopefully be able to meet up with lots of church family and update us all on what has been going on since she left the UK in May, 2019, and outline her future plans.
