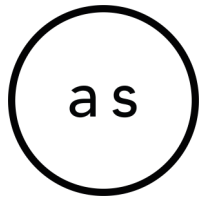

## Hoole Church of England Primary School



Our local MP, Chris Matheson met with children from 8 local primary schools and one high school last week to launch their pupil forum for this academic year. Children from Hoole CE Primary, Acresfield Academy, Chester Bluecoat CE, Newton Primary, Upton Heath Primary, Mill View, Upton Westlea, St Oswald's CE and Upton High sent their pupil forum representatives to meet Mr Matheson and to ask him questions.

The forum was started in 2020 by our school, led by deputy headteacher, Clare Watling. Last year they worked together to raise money to twin toilet blocks and taps in Nigeria and the Democratic Republic of Congo as well as for local charity, Kidsbank. This year, their focus is on pupil wellbeing, giving the children the opportunity to learn what each of their schools do to promote wellbeing and school attendance.

Last week, Mr Matheson met with the children and faced questions from the children about issues that mattered to them, including asking his views on fracking, the war in Ukraine, crime and the fuel crisis.

The Forum are now planning a project across all of the partner school with a focus on supporting children's mental health and wellbeing.
