

The book, published by Dorling Kindersley is a hard back book designed to provide children with a souvenir of the jubilee which they can keep for many years to come.

The book is based on a little girl, Isabella, exploring a treasure box belonging to her Great Granny Joyce. Isabella comes across many mementoes and, as she talks with her great-grandmother about items from the box, the pair go on a trip through time. This journey of discovery through the period of Queen Elizabeth's reign reveals the inspirations, inventions and influences that have transformed the United Kingdom, Commonwealth countries and the wider world.
