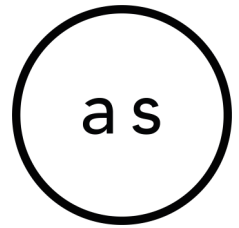

In the 9 days between Ascension (26 May) and Pentecost (5 June) it has been the habit of many Christians, for many centuries, to make the focus of our prayers the same as those first believers, who were waiting for the Holy Spirit of God to be poured out upon them. We are invited to join in with other churches around the country to seek God and to share His love, using resources written by Archbishop Justin Welby and published by Church House.

Copies of these beautifully presented booklets are on the table at the front of church. There is a "Novena" booklet with daily reflections on a single verse in 1 Peter, and an accompanying prayer journal (one set per household). There is also a Cheeky Panda booklet for each of your children.

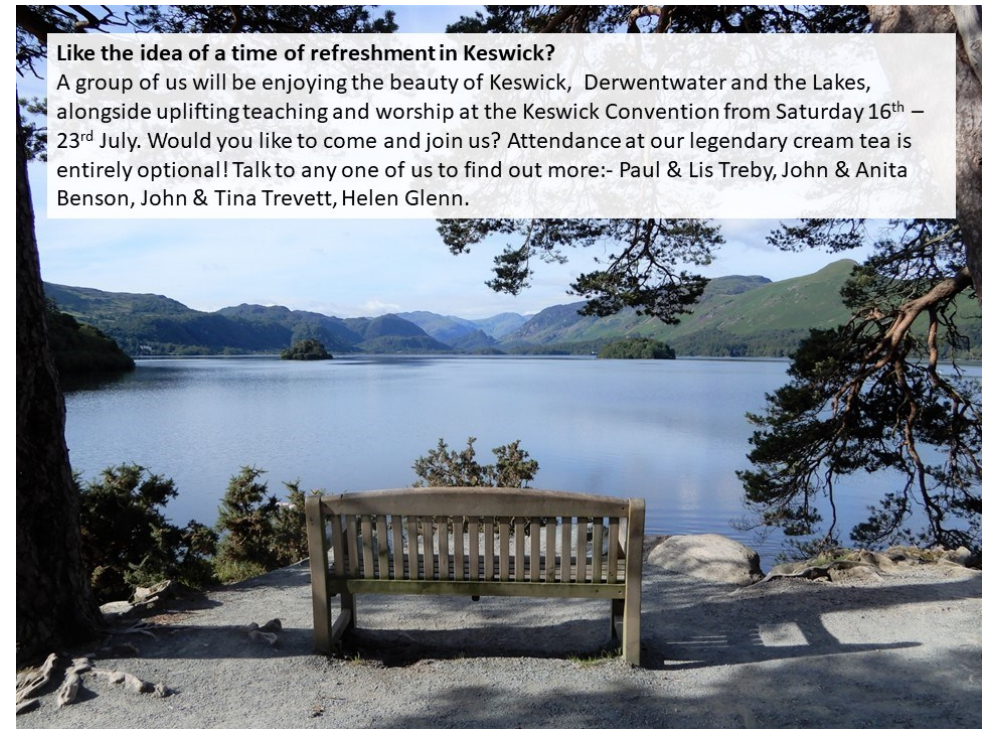

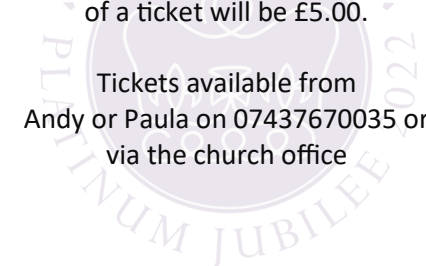
