## Hoole Church of England Primary School



At Hoole, we seek to find as many ways as possible for children to let their lights shine brightly in line with our school vision 'Let your light shine' (Matthew 5:16 Sermon on the Mount.)

Following the disruption to the last two academic years, we are delighted that our pupils have finally had the chance to participate in competitive sports activities in the local area.

We have many children who are talented across a variety of sports including martial arts, netball, cycling, athletics and football. Our pupils are enthusiastic members of many local sports clubs and academy teams, playing regularly and to a very high standard.

Since mid-autumn term, we have been able to reinstate our after school clubs which are very well attended by children of all ages. In addition to drama and arts clubs, we have dodgeball, golf, netball and football clubs running this term for children to enjoy whilst extending their skills. On Fridays mornings before school, children can participate in a daily mile club – completing a mile walking, jogging or running before school even starts!

Our sports teams have been in action over the last two weeks. We sent a girls' football to a tournament two weeks ago. The girls were the first team to wear our new sports kit and they were very excited to don our school colours.

Year six boys were delighted to participate in a local competition this week. A team of seven footballers joined with squads from other local schools for a tournament in Chester. It is such a long time since the children have played competitively against other schools but the players were commended on their sportsmanship and their enthusiasm.

Year five girls were in action at a basketball competition in Ellesmere Port. They played so well and were awarded third place out of ten local teams. They returned to school beaming with pride and so excited to have achieved this for our school family.

It is wonderful to see the opportunities available to children opening up after the challenges of the last two academic years. I hope that this will continue so that we may offer all of our children as many diverse opportunities as possible to let their lights shine brightly.
