

to raise money for the MS Society**



Multiple sclerosis (MS) is a condition that affects your brain and spinal cord. It causes a range of symptoms including affecting how people move, think, feel and see. It is not known exactly what triggers MS and there is no known cure. The MS Society funds research into MS and supports and campaigns on behalf of those affected by MS. There are 4 of us (that I am aware of) at All Saints who have MS and it affects us all in very different ways.

10 years ago I was diagnosed with Multiple Sclerosis (MS). Terrified I would lose my mobility, in 2013 I gave myself the goal of running a mile in under 10 minutes whilst I still had the chance. Apparently every school girl should be able to do this - but it was something I had never managed - I'd always hated running).

I have been fortunate, in that MS has not (yet) affected my mobility (my issues are more hidden). Running has now become a major part of my life and sanity and the mile extended first into being able to run 5k and then in 2015 I managed to run 10k (6.21 miles). Much blood, sweat, injuries & tears later, during lockdown 1, I set myself the goal to be able to run a half marathon (13.1 miles) to raise money for the MSSociety. Having spent the last year training, I am signed up for the 2021 Chester half marathon on 19th September...
