Thanks to all those who contributed online or via the envelopes to Christian Aid Week. £305 was collected though the envelopes in church, plus a further £1305 (at least) online on Chester Christian Aid Committee's JustGiving page. Including Gift Aid, the total sum from All Saints was **£1997**, well above the target of £1400, which was our previous best year (2007).

Not all contributions from our congregation could be identified, and separate fund-raising events are not included, so the total is more than the above figure.

We have been informed by churchsuite that their mail provider recently experienced a technical issue which could possibly have resulted in some emails being delivered using 'To' rather than 'BCC' This would mean that church members email addresses may have been visible to other church members. We have not received any reports of this having happened but in line with GDPR we are making you aware.
