NEWS FROM HOOLE CHURCH OF ENGLAND PRIMARY SCHOOL



We would usually have lots of information to share about fun activities and achievements from school but we are in such unusual times! Our school is overcoming obstacles in new and diverse ways and running slightly differently at present. Despite this, we are proud to continue to let the light of our school family shine brightly.

The majority of our children are engaged in remote learning. Class teachers are providing a morning welcome and input to support children working on their work in English, Mathematics and other areas of the curriculum. In addition to this, pupils also have a weekly social meeting with their classmates so they have opportunities to share news and stay in touch with their friends.

Mrs Elaine Robertson, our school Learning Mentor, has a virtual worry box so that members of our school family can share their worries or concerns. This means that children or their families can still access pastoral support from us despite the fact that they are not in school. Mrs Robertson and a team of dedicated staff are telephoning children throughout the week to offer support, motivation and encouragement.

During the week, we set additional challenges for children to engage with linked to subjects such as Physical Education. We are also currently supporting the National Society for the Protection of Birds (NSPB) with the Big Garden Birdwatch with children monitoring the birds and wildlife visiting their gardens.

We never stand still and our remote learning offer is being enhanced all the time! We have added two weekly collective worship sessions at the start and end of the week and story time session. The story time sessions happen every day at 2.30pm and we are starting with Michael Morpugo's magical tale of adventure, Kensuke's Kingdom.

We have got some exciting plans to coincide with National Storytelling Week which takes place from 30th January – 1st February. Watch this space!
