

VOLUNTEERS NEEDED

Thank you very much to those who have responded to my email last week asking for some support whilst Andy Warren is on sick leave. If you missed the email or didn't get round to replying, we'd still love to hear from you even if you are only able to help as a one-off.

- Mondays and Wednesdays - The floors in Eagle and the main hall need to be mopped (floor cleaner available). This can be done between 1pm and 2pm on a Monday and 10am-12noon on a Wednesday.
- Light cleaning which will involve vacuuming, dusting, glass cleaning.
- Opening up of the centre - There may be the odd occasion where we will need someone to open up for a group in an evening or on a weekend. If you have an entrance fob for the centre and would be happy to help in this way, we will amend your fob to allow access for the required date and time.
