

Some very good news this week... on Sunday a MAF flight arrived in Mandritsara with the Hinds family from UK and Dr Lesley, a retired doctor also from UK returning to Mandritsara for a few months. Lucy Hind is a paediatric consultant and Mark is a teacher; they have two young children and plan to serve at the Good News Project for one year. It is quite a miracle that they got to Mandritsara at all, with very few flights, visas and permits to procure, MAF flight suspended etc etc...but after much prayer and perseverance they got there! It will be such an encouragement to the team to have new faces and also to have Lesley back to support the doctors. Please pray for them as they settle in and adapt to a very different lifestyle.

A Malagassy surgeon is due to join the hospital very soon too which will be wonderful. Please continue to pray for the Theisson family from Canada who are hoping to fly out mid February; Jesh is also a surgeon and they have 3 young children, planning to serve long term at the hospital. They have a long journey and many hurdles to overcome, but we trust that God will go before them and prepare the way.




Living His Story
