

## Hoole Church of England Primary School



We are currently welcoming prospective parents and carers of pupils due to start school in September 2022 for visits to meet our staff and view the school in action.

As part of these visits, we show our extensive grounds and talk to families about how our outdoor spaces, including Forest School, provide countless opportunities for children to be resilient, resourceful, collaborate with others and appreciate the beauty of the natural world.

I have updated you over recent months about our efforts for the Tatton Show and the installation of our new pond area to enrich learning in Science. You will know that we are always striving to improve and create new opportunities for pupils to let their lights shine brightly!

Our latest project is the development of an allotment area for our youngest pupils in Reception.

During half term, we welcomed a team of volunteers from the Co-op store in Hoole. The volunteers spent some time with us, clearing the area and preparing it for development.



Since then, staff have begun to weave a willow dome, which will provide an engaging space for children to observe birds and insects. We harvested the pumpkins children had sown last year and the planters are being prepared for new crops which pupils will help to grow. All through the allotment, there are spaces planned for children to record what crops they are growing and write about what they have seen. There is even a fairy garden to spark up story-telling and drive imaginative play!

Once again, I give thanks for the creativity, enthusiasm and dedication of my staff team in their drive to create yet another purposeful and exciting outdoor space which children can enjoy and learn in.
