We work together with our school family to support children to let their lights shine brightly as:

Over the course of this academic year, it has been wonderful to see how children have let their lights shine in a variety of ways despite the additional challenges we have faced.

Several children have undertaken litter patrols in the local area, showing initiative and respect for their community. We have had a number of pupils who have completed charity runs and other sponsored events for good causes, investing their energy and enthusiasm to raise money for those less fortunate than themselves. Two pupils have recently donated over twenty inches of their hair for the Little Princess Trust, who make wigs for cancer patients.

In March, I received a letter from a group of Year six children regarding single use plastics provided by our catering suppliers. As a result of this action, our catering provider has made a positive change and stopped using plastic spoons at lunchtimes.

In line with our commitment to supporting children in becoming tolerant and responsible citizens, we work with a range of community partners. This week, we are delighted to welcome PCSO Keith Bartlett into school to talk to pupils in Year one to six.

We are proud to celebrate the ways in which children show they are achieving what we want for them and how they are developing personal skills and qualities for the benefit of our community.
