Update on Cathy Armstrong and Mandritsara

Please keep praying for Cathy and the team, and the local community in Mandritsara. See the praise and prayer points from Cathy's most recent update:

Praise points:

- A nurse who I work with on the medical ward tested positive for the virus but was not thankfully too unwell with it and is due to come back to work next week praise God! (I was one of her 'contacts' as had worked a shift with her just before she started showing symptoms and technically should have isolated for 15 days along with 20 other contacts but as this wasn't possible and there were no available tests for us we all continued to work but thankfully I and all other members of staff have remained well which we are so thankful to God for!)
- We're all keeping well in general as a team and keeping going week by week!
- PPE arriving at the hospital from the UK after the 'lightening appeal' a few months back (thank you to all who contributed financially and prayed!)
- Cheese and apples!!
- Being able to take a break from work for a week.
- Dr Tefy (Malagasy trainee surgeon) and his wife Diana had a baby boy (and are all doing well!)

Prayer points:

- For God's continued protection over the region and town of Mandritsara and it's people.
- For those who are scared, especially who work in the hospital for the coming few months
- For the water situation - that the part they need for the pump from Tana would be able to get here soon.
- For staffing at the hospital as some staff who are classed as vulnerable and those who are 7 months pregnant need to stay at home
- Continued strength and resilience for the team here as the weeks and months go on without any visitors or respite especially for the doctors or being able to take a proper break.
- For the family of Alfred (who was a part of the evangelism team at the hospital and part of our church) who sadly died last week after a short battle with cancer.
- For the hospital leadership - that they would be able to make clear and wise decisions together and seek God's wisdom.
