


Introducing Two New Faces at All Saints

All Saints Church Youth Group - End of Year Review

This has been my first 'full year' as Youth worker at All Saints Hoole, and at the risk of sounding too cliché...what a year it has been! As a qualified teacher and someone who works in schools, I tend to run on the academic summer to summer calendar, so here is the All Saints Youth, end of year review:

"As we come to the end of another exciting and faith-filled year, we want to take a moment to reflect on all that God has done through our youth group at All Saints.





Sunday Mornings

Our Sunday morning sessions have provided a strong foundation for our young people to grow in their faith. This year, we've journeyed through:

- The "I AM" series exploring who Jesus is through His own words.
- · Handling Emotions learning how to bring our feelings to God, and using His words to help us.
- The Bible Explored helping young people understand and engage with Scripture whilst digging deeper into specific books.

Sunday Evenings

Our Sunday evening gatherings have been split into a three-week rotation to offer variety and depth: Ignite & Testimonies - evenings of worship, reflection, and real-life faith stories shared by Gemma, Pam, Lis, Andy, Alan, Andy, and Wendy.

Bible Study - We have used the brand-new Youth Alpha series and explored Apologetics digging deeper into God's Word and how it applies to everyday life.

Social Nights - building friendships and creating memories with fun and welcoming events such as:

- Paddle boarding
- Bowling
- Murder Mystery Night
- · Christmas Party
- Games Night
- Nerf Wars
- Glas DevaGo-Karting
- Aqua Park at Manley Mere
- Family Fun Night
- Bouncy Castle Evening

These evenings have been a great way for young people to invite friends and grow in community together. All of our evening events include a hot meal, and we are so thankful to the whole catering team who make this possible; Pat, Alan, Andy, Paula, Debbie and Ken (thankyou sooo much)

Schools Ministry & Wider Connections

This year, we've also partnered closely with CSCW (Christian Schools Christian Workers), regularly visiting two local secondary schools (Bishop's and Upton) to run lunch clubs - providing a safe space for young people to belong and have the opportunity to ask big questions about life and faith during the school day.

In addition, we've continued to work alongside other local youth leaders through Link Up as YTHX, coming together monthly for united worship events. These evenings have focused on helping our young people know their value and worth in Jesus, through biblical teaching and encouragement. Similarly, we had our annual weekend away at Cefn Lea in October and are already planning next years!

We are so thankful for all God has done this year - for the lives impacted, the friendships formed, and the faith that has grown. Thank you to every leader, parent, caterer and young person who has been part of this journey. Here's to another year of growing together in Christ!

10am to 12 noon. £2.50 per family.




